Throughout April and May, Pastor Wes led an inspiring sermon series titled "The Power of One." The series delved into the significance of individual contributions and how they collectively make a profound impact on our community and beyond.

Week One

Speaker: Pastor Wes Scripture: Matthew 25:14-30 (The Parable of the Talents)

Key Points:

- Use what you are given without comparison.
- The power of your "one" can make a difference.
- You are made in God's image and have a purpose.

Homework: <u>Listen to "The Power of One" by Israel</u> <u>Houghton</u>.

Week Two

Speaker: Pastor Wes Scripture: Genesis 11:1-4 Principles:

- Communication (Genesis 11:1): Effective communication involves not just words, but also body language and tone.
- Competence (Genesis 11:3): Achieving goals requires the necessary skills and resources. Understanding and adapting to your environment is crucial.
- Clarity/Vision (Genesis 11:4): A clear vision unites people and garners divine attention. When people are one, they win.

Week Three

Speaker: Jamila Logan Scripture: Judges 4 (Deborah's Leadership) Key Points:

- Be effective in your actions; your results will speak for themselves.
- Courage and encouragement are essential in empowering others.
- Use God-given power to protect and serve the community.

Week Four

Speaker: Pastor Wes Scripture: Ephesians 5:21-33 Key Takeaway:

• Equality and Balance: Both partners must work together, respecting and valuing each other's contributions to achieve unity.

The meeting concluded with a prayer for the church, its upcoming initiatives, and the community we serve. If you missed the business meeting, watch a replay of it <u>here</u>.




DISCOVER IN THE COMMUNITY: PATUXENT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SPORTS DAY



Next Steps – Have the student complete the brief questionnaire, then review the report to understand the student's personality, strengths and areas of development. Then identify multiple career interests based on reports to research in the Occupational Outlook Handbook.

Occupational Outlook Handbook - The Occupational Outlook Handbook is a publication of the Bureau of Labor Statistics that includes information about the nature of work, working conditions, training and education, earnings and job outlook for hundreds of different occupations in the United States.

Next Steps – As the student evaluates each aspect of the various careers, he/she should create a <u>T-chart</u> listing the pros of the career on the left and the cons on the right side of the T-chart. Next, the student should evaluate the careers to identify the child's top three interests and be prepared to share with parents why they believe the career choices are good options.





<u>College Navigator</u> - Resource for institutional data on programs offered, retention and graduation rates, prices, aid available, degrees awarded, campus safety and more.

Next Steps – Search for colleges that offer degree programs to prepare the student for their top three career interests. Research information about the college and visit the website to learn about the degree programs, resources to help the students succeed and student outcomes. Avoid applying to public universities outside of your residential state. Select colleges based on good fit for career preparation and affordability. Remember, a student should not take on student loans that exceed his/her expected first year income.

<u>**Common Application</u>** - Central hub to apply to multiple colleges from one website.</u>
