SUPPORTING PBIS AT PATUXENT ELEMENTARY

That's why we're proud to partner each month with Patuxent Elementary School to support their PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) program —an initiative focused on encouraging and rewarding positive behavior among students. Through this ongoing partnership, DCC provides materials and volunteers needed for PBIS events, helping to create fun and meaningful experiences that uplift students and remind them their hard work matters. We helped supply plastic Easter eggs and candy for this celebration that reminded students how much their efforts are appreciated!

DCC provided face paint kits, games, a popcorn maker and bubble machine to ramp up the fun.

To help students cool off and have fun, we donated over 4,000 water balloons—turning the playground into a place of laughter, fun, and well-deserved joy.


